Auriga Industries A/S is the parent company in a group with three producing subsidiaries, Cheminova A/S, Hardi International A/S and Skamol A/S.

The Auriga group is an international business with a revenue of more than 5 billion Danish kroner per year from sales in more than 100 countries worldwide. The group has approx. 2,900 employees working in 37 companies in 21 countries. The group owns production facilities on four continents.

Cheminova is the largest company in the group. Cheminova's core activity is the development, production and marketing of plant protection products for the eradication of weeds, insects and fungi. Cheminova has a market-leading position within several of its business areas.

Hardi is one of the world's leading manufacturers of sprayers and spraying equipment for efficient and environmentally sound plant care. The company develops and markets high-performance precision sprayers for all crop types.

Skamol is a leading manufacturer of materials for high-temperature insulation in the temperature range up to 1,150°C. Skamol also develops and markets insulation products for fire protection.

Auriga Industries is listed on the Copenhagen Stock Exchange (OMX Group).
